

Pipelines in Pennsylvania

Atlantic Sunrise, Williams Partners, 10 counties affected, including Lancaster and Lebanon.

Connects the Marcellus Shale producing areas, in North Eastern PA to Mid-Atlantic and South Eastern States. 183 miles long. Final approval given early 2017. Construction to begin mid-2017.
